Comments: Mycoparasitic on fleshy forest mushrooms (Norvell 2002)

**Threat Impact:** C = Medium

Comments: Based on forest habitat, assumed to be impacted by timber harvest and associated activities throughout its range.

**Intrinsic  
Vulnerability:** B = Moderately vulnerable

Comments: Assumed to be vulnerable to removal of host mushroom, removal of protective sclerotia during dormancy and to general destruction to its forest habitat (Norvell 2002)

**Heritage Rank:** S3?

Comments: Although occurrence numbers are low and the species is considered rare when found, the range extent within the state is rather large.
