Comments: Small, local population size, but relatively wide distribution in appropriate habitat across state. Widespread threats from forest management practices.

**Range Extent:** F = 20,000-200,000 sq km (~8,000-80,000 sq mi)

Comments: 44,949 sq km range extent based on post-2000 PODs records.

**Population Size:** D = 1,000 - 2,500 individuals

Comments: 1,100 Population estimate for OR based on PIF population estimate database.

**Number of Occurrences:** B = 6 - 20

Comments: Approximately 11 occurrences based on post-2000 PODs records, buffered to 5km separation distance.

**Area of Occupancy:** F = 126-500 4-km<sup>2</sup> grid cells

Comments: 334 4km<sup>2</sup> grid cells, based on post-2000 PODs records buffered to 5km.

**Good Viability:** C = Few (4-12) occurrences with excellent or good viability or ecological integrity

Comments: 11/162 PODs records are post-2000.

**Environmental Sensitivity:** Not Evaluated

Comments: No discernable trend information available.

Comments:

Forest practices that remove beetle infested or burned timber can negatively affect this species. Threats from forest fragmentation, fire suppression, salvage logging.
