**Occurrences:** D = 81 - 300

Comments: 231 potential EOs based on PODs data (did not include BBA possible records) and 5km separation distance as recommended by NatureServe. This species is not tracked by ORBIC.

**Area of Occupancy:** F = 126-500 4-km<sup>2</sup> grid cells

Comments: 449 4-km<sup>2</sup> grid cells based on PODs data

**Good Viability:** U = Unknown

**Specificity:** Not Evaluated

Comments: None

**Short Term Trends:** DE = Decline of 30 - 70%

Comments: Raphael et al. (1988) saw large population declines in Douglas-fir forests of northern CA from presettlement. PIF data show significant population decline <50% in W OR, moderate to large decrease in Great Basin, and possible small decrease in Northern Rockies.

**Long Term Trends:** E = Decline of 30 - 50%

Comments: BBS data show significant decline 1966-1999.

**Threat Impact:** C = Medium

Comments: Past and future habitat loss to logging. Habitat usually unsuitable following fire.

**Heritage Rank:** S3

Comments: Large declines and moderate threats to habitat.
